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### **Performance Notes:**

### <u>Tempo</u>

There is a strict relationship between the tempi of the different movements. If it is decided to change a single movement's tempo the other tempi should change accordingly:

The 2nd movement is 2/3 of the 1st movement: I = 100, II = 66The 4th movement is 2/3 of the 3rd movement: III = 114, IV = 76The 6th movement is 2/3 of the 5th movement and 1/2 of the 7th: V = 90, VI = 60, VII = 120

### Percussion:

The Drum set (movements I and VII) should sound tight and groovy!

The Kalimba should be placed on a timpani for resonance and perhaps amplified as well.

The Marimba and Vibraphone are both played with the same mallets and they should stand 90 degrees to one another so the change between them is instant.





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







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
